THE NEW CHAMBER CHOIR



The New Chamber Choir was formed in 2013 by a group of singers from a number of choral groups and choirs who wanted to try something new: they wanted to explore and sing the whole of the choral repertoire, rather than to concentrate on just one style or genre. The idea was that the choir would switch between madrigals and jazz, or between church masses and contemporary folksongs. The challenge would be to master the variety.

NCC members are invited to join, and come from across Yorkshire and Derbyshire. They meet for occasional 'workshop' days before coming together for a performance. The choir has given concerts across the region, including for the National Trust and the Friends of the Peak District, and has undertaken two overseas tours, to northern Provence.
